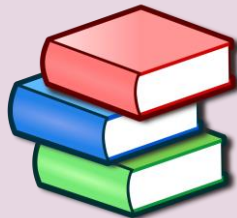

Back Alley Construction Project:

On August 30th contractors started on the back-alley rehabilitation project of the alley running behind the Foundry/ATB/Jade Garden/Trius Insurance/Hotel and also behind Country Automotive/Village Glass/Telus. Please be aware of disruptions in this area during this time.

Once this project is completed, the contractors will be moving to 5 other locations in Town and completing various road rehabilitation work. It is anticipated this construction project will start in mid to end of September. These areas are: 49 Ave (Shaul) & 53 Street/Lovell Close/Lac Ste. Anne Trail North (near Industrial Avenue intersection)/Industrial Avenue (south of LSA Trail)/47 Avenue (where previous line repair was done)
