I submit this recall for the following reasons:

- 1) Lack of public trust and confidence in these elected officials over the past 2 years.
- 2) Breached their oath of office no less than 11 times and continue to do so.
- 3) Ending staff and essential service contracts without cause and without public notification or information. A former town employee, now councillor, has made it her mission to remove all who were employed when she was fired. She has the majority vote with her friends being the mayor and deputy mayor, respectively. This personal vendetta has come at great cost to the Town. Large payouts and legal costs using Town reserves has left the Town in a precarious situation, being there are not enough funds should an emergency arise.
- 4) Creating a toxic environment resulting in tenants from the town office leaving, reducing town income. Now they are using taxpayers dollars to renovate the space to accommodate an increase in staff when population remains the same.
