Fines only (*does not apply to lost items*) will be waived once we have received your donation. Drop in now, clear up your account and help out local food bank!

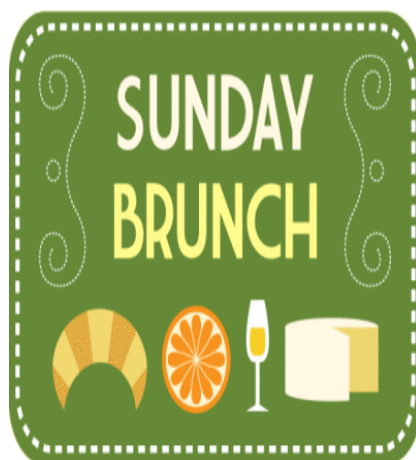
