

**VILLAGE OF ONOWAY**  
**By-Law 503-97**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ONOWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND CREATING TITLE TO AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.**

**WHEREAS**, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and  
**WHEREAS** application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and  
**WHEREAS** the Council of the Village of Onoway deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the same municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposing of same, and  
**WHEREAS** Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Village of Onoway in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and create titles to with the intent of disposing of the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

- 1) **Plan 1795 MC**  
**All of Main Avenue**  
**(NE 27-54-2-5)**  
**Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.**
  
- 2) **Plan 772 0696**  
**All that portion of Main Avenue lying west of the production northerly of the west boundary of Lot R1 (Reserve) said plan.**  
**(NE 27-54-2-5)**  
**Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.**
  
- 3) **Plan 772 0696**  
**All that portion of Main Avenue lying east of the production northerly of the west boundary of Lot R1 (Reserve) said plan.**  
**(NE 27-54-2-5)**  
**Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.**
