

VILLAGE OF ONOWAY
By-Law 583-02

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ONOWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESTRICTING THROUGH TRAVEL ON A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY AS DEFINED IN THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the roadway established to access the park known as the Elks Park closed to through traffic because of concerns of speeding and danger to children using the park area, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Onoway recognizes the issues of public safety that are of concern to the residents of the area and deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of restricting through travel on this access road; and

WHEREAS Council will give notice that this restriction to traffic, as allowed in Section 16 (p) of the Highway Traffic Act, is planned, to allow any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw an opportunity to be heard by Council prior to final reading of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Onoway in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to through travel on the access road to the Elks Park, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:
