BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ONOWAY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS AND THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Section 143, 144, 150 and 151 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000 or thereof amended, Council may pass bylaws or municipal purposes respecting the Appointment of a Chief Elected Official and election of four (4) Councillors;


AND WHEREAS it is desirable and in the best interest of the Town of Onoway that a Bylaw be passed regulating, the Appointment of a Chief Elected Official and four (4) Councillors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Onoway, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:


1. That five (5) Councillors be elected by the Town of Onoway Voters, for the terms outline in the Local Authorities Election Act;
2. That the Chief Elected Official (Mayor) be appointed by and from among the Councillors;
3. The Appointment of the Chief Elected Official (Mayor) shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date of initial appointment;
4. That the Appointment will begin the first organizational meeting held after the 2010 General Election;
5. That the Appointment will take place at each consecutive Organizational meeting beginning in 2011;
6. That Bylaw 658-07 be rescinded; and
7. That this Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.




