Through the month of August Public Works will be performing routine line painting throughout Town. Please watch for parking restrictions and our staff working on the roadways.

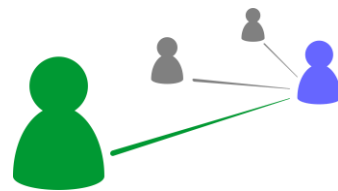
